Trees & Utilities National Conference - Municipal/Nonprofit Nomination

Dear Tree Line USA Participant:

We have heard from some of our Tree Line USA participants that they would love to encourage representatives of nonprofit tree planting groups and municipalities to attend the Trees & Utilities National Conference.

Your utility has been selected to have the opportunity to nominate a representative of a nonprofit tree planting group or municipality in your service territory to attend this year's Trees & Utilities National Conference at a scholarship rate of \$189. The full conference rate is \$379/\$329 with early registration. This year's conference is April 7-9, 2008, at the Wyndham Orlando Resort in Orlando, Florida.

To nominate a participant, please visit www.arboday.org/TUnominate. There you will complete a simple form providing the contact information for the person you wish to nominate. We will then send them a packet by first class mail containing a brochure for the conference, a scholarship registration form, and a cover letter telling them that they were nominated to receive this scholarship rate by their local utility. We suggest that you complete your nomination as soon as possible, preferably by February 15. If you represent a municipal utility, you may not nominate another employee of the utility, but you are free to nominate an employee of another municipal department.
